Vaccinations:

All pets must be up to date on their vaccinations. If the vaccinations were administered at another veterinary hospital, it is the owner's responsibility to provide proof of vaccinations prior to or at the time the pet is admitted for boarding. Failure to do so, will result in vaccination(s) being administered and charged accordingly.

Boarding animals less than four months of age is not recommended because they may not have developed complete immunity. In the event that this is necessary, additional isolation charges may apply.

Internal/External Parasites:

All pets must be free of parasites, including fleas & ticks. Pets brought in with parasites will require treatment at the owner's expense.

Medical Illness Policy:

One of the advantages of boarding your pet(s) at a Veterinary Hospital is that medical attention is readily available for our guests. If your pet needs medical attention, we will contact you (then your emergency



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contact). If we are unable to make contact, we will treat your pet(s) as deemed necessary at normal hospital fees. If your pet is currently on medication, please inform the medical team upon admission.

Personal Belongings:

Since pets are not monitored 24 hours a day, we do not place personal belongings with patients. While boarding, patients can exhibit abnormal behaviors (chewing on bedding, soiling of kennel) due to the stress of being out of their normal routine. We provide adequate bedding, bowls and leashes that allow our staff to monitor your pet(s) behavior and prevent potential ingestion/destruction of items.

Inherent Conditions:

Occasionally pets may develop problems from environmental and dietary changes. Signs may include: vomiting, diarrhea, coughing, sneezing and self-trauma (scratching or biting their skin). We take great care so that these problems won't occur and we treat our guests promptly, if needed. However, please be aware and understand that these conditions can develop and that the hospital is not financially responsible for these inherent conditions, if they do occur.

In Case of Injury or Illness:

While my pet(s) are in your care, I authorize the use of anesthesia, surgical or therapeutic procedures as VCA deems necessary. In the event that emergency or after-hours medical care is required that VCA is unable to provide, and VCA is not able to reach myself or my emergency contact, I authorize VCA to transfer my pet to a 24-hour emergency care facility and accept responsibility for all charges incurred in connection therewith. I agree to indemnify and hold VCA and its employees harmless from and against all liability arising out of the performance of the procedures or actions referred to above.
